The University of Central Oklahoma (Central) has [114 undergraduate majors](#) and [63 graduate majors](#), including [Forensic Science](#), Music Theatre, Graphic Design, Mass Communications, Teacher Education, Accounting, [Professional Golf Management](#) (only accredited program in the region), and Jazz Studies. The [Academy of Contemporary Music](#) at UCO, located in downtown Oklahoma City's Bricktown district, is all about creating a "real-world" experience for students by introducing them to the music industry. For those interested in pursuing careers related to athletics, Central is one of only two universities in the United States named an official U.S. Olympic and Paralympic Training Site.

The [UCO Broncho athletic teams](#) compete in the NCAA Division II Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association conference. The university's athletics program has a rich tradition of success, most recently winning the 2013 NCAA Division II National Softball Championship.



[The University of Central Oklahoma hockey club](#) won its [first national title](#) in the ACHA Division I 2015 National Championship after shutting out the Stony Brook University Seawolves 4-0.
