[Keck Graduate Institute of Applied Life Sciences \(KGI\)](#) is located in Claremont, CA, a contemporary college town located 40 minutes from downtown Los Angeles. KGI is a member of the prestigious [Claremont Colleges](#) consortium.

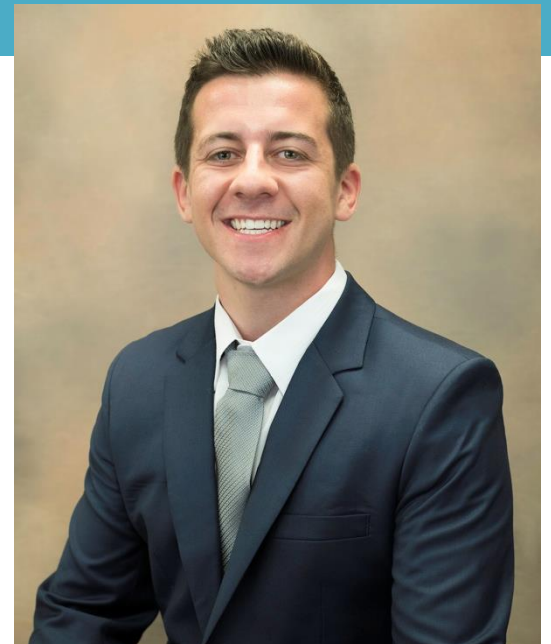
Keck Graduate Institute is the only American graduate institution devoted solely to preparing students for careers in medicine, pharmacy, engineering, and biotechnology. With a student population of 195 and a 9:1 student/faculty ratio, KGI students receive individualized attention with their studies and research.



Each student in KGI's innovative [Masters of Bioscience \(MBS\)](#) program will gain the technical and business skills to compete and contribute to the growing life sciences industry.

All MBS students complete a 3-month paid industry internship and participate in a 9-month consultancy project sponsored by one of KGI's many industry partners. Students get on-the-job training necessary to secure positions after graduation.

Within 6 months of graduation, 96% of students receive job offers. This figure is even more remarkable considering that the student body is 38% international. Young graduates are finding fantastic opportunities both in the United States and abroad. The average starting salary of an MBS graduate is over \$70,000 per year. A recent survey (2015) shows that students between 5 and 10 years from graduation are earning an average salary of \$111,231.
