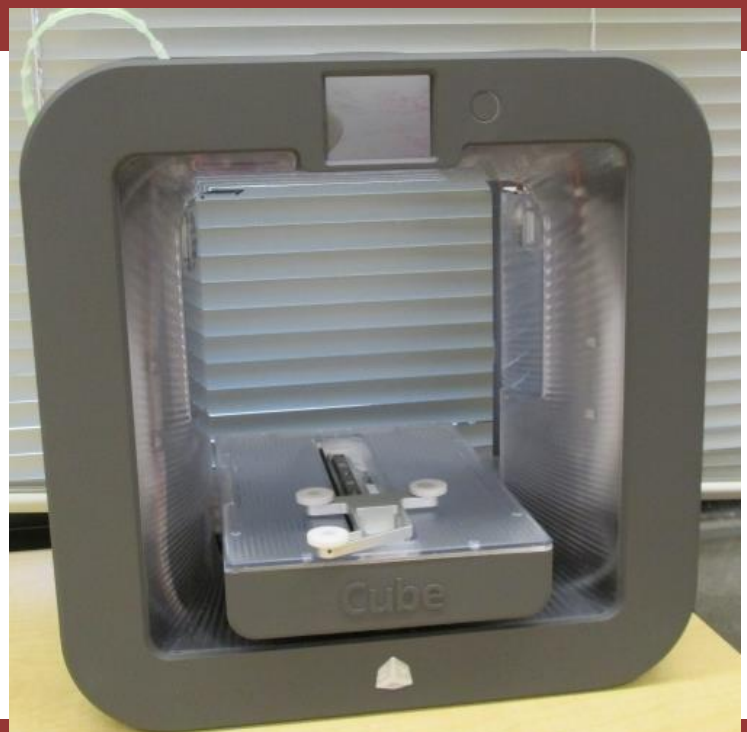
Florida State University School of Information

In Tallahassee, Florida

The iSchool at Florida State University ([FSU iSchool](#)) educates students to be leaders in careers that make vital connections between people, information and technology. Students at the iSchool learn about information management and information technology in [undergraduate](#), [Masters'](#) and [PhD](#) degrees in [Information Technology](#) and [Information Studies](#) for careers involving cyber security, networking, web development and web server administration, database management, health informatics, multimedia and social media management. Students at the iSchool gain expertise for careers involving information management, digital libraries, information systems, and information services, including services to today's "digital youth" who are growing up as digital natives.



The FSU iSchool on [Florida State University's](#) main campus in Tallahassee offers a Collaboratory [information makerspace](#) within the Harold Goldstein Library, where students can work on projects with technologies including 3-D printers and 3-D modeling stations, Oculus Rift 3D virtual reality visors, and Raspberry Pi and Little Bits circuit-building kits.



The FSU campus in Tallahassee is also home to the [Flying High Circus](#), where FSU students can participate in circus class and join as performers in circus acts from juggling and tightrope-walking to the flying trapeze. FSU students enjoy a vibrant cultural life, including the [Opening Nights](#) series in which musicians, artists and writers from around the world come to FSU both to perform and also to work with students in classes. FSU also has a long and proud tradition of excellence in [collegiate sports](#).
