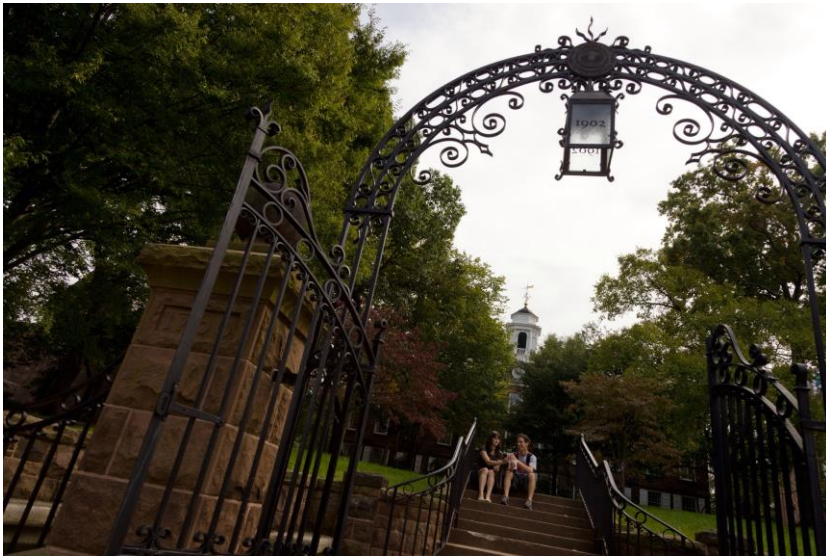

# Rutgers University

Camden, Newark, and New Brunswick, New Jersey



Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, is the eighth oldest institution of higher education in the United States, established in 1766. Rutgers is located on the mid-Atlantic coast and is home to students from all fifty U.S. states and more than 115 countries.

Rutgers boasts more than 100 undergraduate majors, dozens of study abroad options, 4,000+ courses, and 400+ student organizations. The athletic programs across the three campuses include NCAA Division I (Big Ten) teams (Rutgers University – New Brunswick), highly competitive NCAA Division III teams (Rutgers University-Camden and Rutgers University-Newark), and club and intramural-level sports at every location. There is something for everyone at Rutgers!

The top three majors that Canadian Rutgers students choose are Engineering, Business, and Pharmacology. Although most Canadians at Rutgers hail from Ontario, almost every province is represented on campus. Rutgers is recognized as a leader in the diversity of its student body. Additionally, they have strong academic programs, cutting-edge research, and high civic engagement. Rutgers continually records a high retention rate: 91% among first year students! Undergraduate first-year students who apply by the regular action due date of December 1 (for the following fall semester) are automatically considered for scholarships and honors programs. - with essay (required for first-year applicants and recommended for transfer applicants)
- \$65 application fee
- [Self-Reported Academic Record \(SRAR\)](#) (current high school students only); or official high school and any college/ university transcripts (all other applicants)
- [SAT](#) or [ACT](#) score with the writing section (if you graduated high school fewer than two years before you would enter)

Please complete the online application by the following due dates and submit required credentials no later than two weeks after that. You may apply even after these due dates, but your application may be withdrawn if your application is incomplete or when schools meet their enrollment goals.

- Fall/September –
  - First Year Applicants: November 1 for Early Action, December 1 for Regular Action
  - Transfer Applicants : February 1
- Spring/January
  - All Applicants: October 1
