INTERNATIONAL HYBRID MASTERS PROGRAM

UCLA Engineering's International Hybrid Masters Program enables working engineers and computer scientists to expand their technical knowledge beyond the Bachelor of Science level.



Year 1 - Online

MUST MEET Minimum UCLA Admission

- 1st year must be done completely online (4-5 courses)
- GPA of 3.0 or higher in UCLA coursework taken online is needed to be accepted to be accepted into the residency program

Year 2 - On-Campus Residency

1 Quarter to 1 Year

UCLA Residency

- The remaining courses can be taken in Residency at UCLA
- Combined with courses in Intensive English and Culture Interaction (optional)

Expenses

- For on-campus portion, students pay for tuition, living expenses, and health insurance. (Must show proof of financial responsibility for F1 or J1 visa).
- Over 50% cost savings compared to 2-year on-campus program

Optional Practical Training

- Students completing the degree are eligible for Optional Practical Training - OPT
- OPT allows visiting students to work in the USA
- Requires 1 YR of Full time study at UCLA
