Bryant University is a leader in innovative education. Bryant's interdisciplinary curriculum combines business and liberal arts to give students an unparalleled, competitive advantage. Bryant's student-centered environment integrates real-world knowledge with global perspective, design-thinking and leadership development to empower students.



The College of Arts and Sciences encourages active and engaged learning through research projects, service learning and international experiences. Liberal arts classes teach Bryant students to think critically and problem solve. Bryant offers dynamic and plentiful opportunities to develop teamwork and leadership skills in fields including Science, Economics, Psychology, Politics and Law, Communications and Languages.



The AACSB-Accredited [College of Business](#) at Bryant offers many opportunities for students interested in International Business, Accounting, Computer Information Systems, Entrepreneurship, Finance, Global Supply Chain Management and Marketing. Through business classes, students learn about organizational structure, fiduciary decision making and market development. Strategic alliances and partnerships with regional businesses, community organizations, multinational corporations and global institutions offer additional learning opportunities to students.



At Bryant, all students must choose at least a major from one college and at least a minor from the other, but students are encouraged to explore academic options: 45% of students complete double, triple or even quadruple concentrations. Faculty are dedicated mentors and partners who bring professional experiences to the classroom to collaborate with students on research and community projects. Students are encouraged to use [internships](#) to gain hands-on experience. This gives Bryant students the skills they need to become innovative leaders: one in ten Bryant alumni in the workplace hold the title of CEO, COO and/or CFO and 99% of the students who graduated in 2015 were employed or in graduate school within six months of graduation with a \$55,000 USD median first-year salary. Students also start their own businesses: this year, recent Bryant graduate [Nick Candito](#) was recognized in Forbes Magazine's "30 Under 30 Enterprise Technology" for a company he co-founded after graduating from Bryant.

Bryant University is located on a safe, friendly campus in Smithfield, Rhode Island. The campus includes 3,500 students from 60 countries, and students are encouraged to get involved on-campus: Bryant offers over 100 [student clubs and organizations](#) as well as 22 [NCAA Division I athletic teams](#). Bryant's community and academics prepare students to fulfil intellectual, personal and career-related goals by preparing students to make a difference in the world around them.
