


The Ohio State University

Established in 1870, The Ohio State University is a world-class <u>research</u> university located in <u>Columbus</u>, Ohio, the state's capital and largest city and the 15th largest city in the United States. Ohio State has attained national and international distinction in education and research and is ranked among the top 20 public universities in the United States (U.S. News & World Report). Students benefit from a scholarly environment in which research inspires and informs teaching.



Ohio State offers more than 200 undergraduate <u>majors</u> (from liberal arts to biological sciences), 492 areas of specialization, more than 1,000 student <u>organizations</u> and co-op/internship opportunities in every field. Experiences in and out of the classroom help students network, gain skills and strengthen their preparation for employment or graduate school. Our students take advantage of opportunities to pursue co-ops and internships in <u>Columbus'</u> strength areas of research and technology, healthcare, insurance and service <u>businesses</u>.











Ohio State ranks amongst the top 12 public research universities in the United States. The university's research labs, expert faculty and ties to industry result in a high ranking for Ohio State's programs in the biological, medical and physical sciences, as well as in technology and engineering.
