The University of Texas at Tyler (UT Tyler), founded in 1971, is one of the fastest-growing institutions in the reputable University of Texas System which is comprised of eight universities and six health institutions, located throughout Texas. Surrounded by the natural beauty of East Texas, UT Tyler is located midway between Dallas, Texas and Shreveport, Louisiana. The City of Tyler has a population of over 100,000 and is known as the "Rose Capital of America."



UT Tyler values solid traditions of learning and innovative, results-driven research, providing intellectually enriching opportunities for academically talented and motivated students from around the world. UT Tyler's current enrollment of almost 10,000 students represents all 50 U.S. states and over 50 countries.

UT Tyler offers an affordable, nurturing environment for student success in six colleges: Arts & Sciences, Business & Technology, Education & Psychology, Engineering, Nursing & Health Sciences and Pharmacy. Over 80 undergraduate and graduate academic degree programs are delivered by faculty who are scholars in their fields of study, and who work closely with students in classes averaging an 18:1 student-to-professor ratio, and is listed as a top 20 Texas university by U.S. News and World Report. UT Tyler's most popular <u>degrees</u> are: Nursing, Education, Management, Kinesiology, Psychology, Criminal Justice, Biology, History, Accounting and Marketing.

The Office of International Programs (OIP) at UT Tyler provides international students with advising assistance, acquiring health insurance and obtaining an I-20, and offers academic English studies through the Intensive English Language Institute (IELI). IELI assists non-native English speakers in improving academic English language and American culture skills, and prepares for university admittance and success in a global environment. To date, students from 21 nations have studied at IELI. IELI instructors are seasoned educators with overseas and cross-cultural experience that has prepared them to assist newly-arrived students. Students gain fluency through interactive methods, like field trips, presentations, and online study practices. UT Tyler offers an English proficiency waiver to high-achieving upper level students who are interested in enrolling in the undergraduate and graduate programs. Campus housing and scholarships are available for international students. UT Tyler is home to nearly 100 student organizations, representing the diverse interests of the students on campus.
