

## Utah State University in Logan, Utah





Utah State University is located in Cache Valley, Utah in the city of Logan. Logan is one and a half hours north of Salt Lake City, where the 2002 Winter Olympics were held. USU was founded in 1888 as an agricultural college and has grown to one of the nation's premier student-centered, land-grant and space-grant universities.

USU is located next to the <u>Rocky Mountains</u> where skiing, snowboarding, hiking, fishing, rock climbing, swimming and fishing are only minutes away.



USU offers over 165 undergraduate degrees and over 170 graduate degrees. USU has eight colleges: agriculture, business, engineering, natural resources, humanities, arts, science, and education.

program, which has a partnership
with <u>NASA</u>, and <u>Aviation Technology</u>
program allow students to work on
and fly planes at the Logan Airport.

The student life is great, as USU is ranked in the top 20 safest college campuses in the USA, and student can get discounts on shopping, groceries, movies and entertainment. Students also enjoy free public transportation and can get free bikes.

USU offers more than 1,100 <u>on-campus</u> <u>jobs</u> and international students can work part-time jobs on campus up to 20 hours a week.
