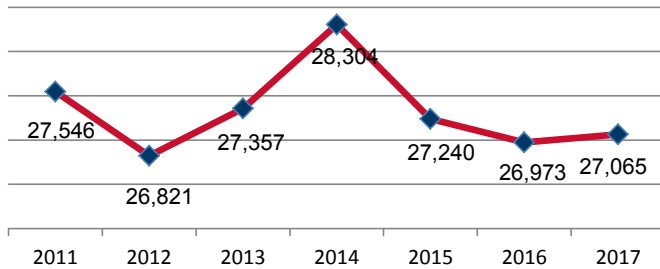

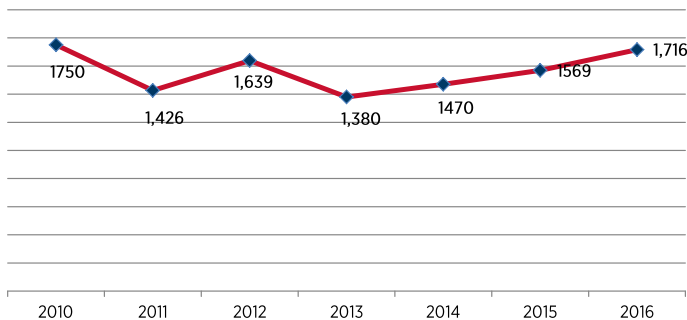


Students Studying in the U.S.
